### TECHNIQUE AND INNOVATION

The techniques used throughout this proposal represent different phases of the artist's artistic development:

**Phase One**: During Avi's formative development, the artist experimented with quilt-making and appliqué inspired by her grandmother.

**Phase Two**: As an economist, educator, and historian, Avis began to represent human figures that depict historical subjects and personalities.

**Phase Three**: Avis combined early textile work with experimentations with paint and textures to reinvent and reimagine her subjects.
